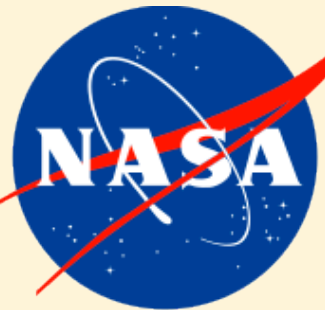


School Field Trips

Since opening in 2012, over 10,000 students from East Texas schools and beyond have visited the Naranjo Museum. For rural schools, the Naranjo Museum offers educational experiences that would otherwise require travel to Houston or Dallas.

Museum Partnerships

The Naranjo Museum of Natural History has partnered with other institutions to bring in new exhibits and share pieces of the Naranjo collection. The museum currently hosts several exhibits from NASA including one of the largest lunar samples in circulation.



Preservation

The Naranjo Museum houses over 1,000 fossils and artifacts from all periods of the Earth's history. Museum staff use computer software to archive and inventory fossils and artifacts to help organize and preserve the museum collection.
